Minutes

- → The meeting began with Dr. Anagha Tendulkar welcoming members of IQAC.
- → The agenda of the meeting was to review the initiatives taken by the IQAC in the second half of the academic year 2021-2022.
- → The minutes of the previous IQAC meeting, held on 27th November 2021 was shared, Dr. T.C. Roymon proposed the minutes and Mrs. Boskey Martis seconded it.

Dr. Anagha Tendulkar presented to the committee a PowerPoint presentation showing the review of the activities undertaken by IQAC in the academic year 2021-2022.

- 1. The IQAC launched the new college website, which appeared to be more organized and vibrant.
- **2.** IQAC successfully published the soft/e-copy of the College handbook for the year 2021-2022 on the new website.
- **3.** IQAC conducted elections for the posts of Student Body President and Cultural Secretary online via google form, with the IQAC coordinator Dr. Anagha Tendulkar acting as a presiding officer.
- **4.** IQAC played a pivotal role in the College's participation in the India Today survey, the Week Survey, and the NIRF rankings. The India Today has published the rankings, the Week never gives the ranking, and the College has received the certificate of participation from the NIRF.
- **5.** The IQAC expanded with the following sub-committees: The program subcommittee, the Documentation and feedback subcommittee, and the CAS subcommittee. Ms. Tanaz Asha, Dr. T.C. Roymon, and Dr. Trevor Allis acted as the coordinators for the program, documentation & feedback, and CAS subcommittees.
- **6.** IQAC conducted a faculty program on add-on courses on 10th July 2021 to make all staff members aware of the design, structure, and elements of the add-on courses. Dr. Roshan D'Souza, an In-house faculty member, was the resource person.
- **7.** Program committee conducted a series of online orientation sessions on Add-on credits and Swayam courses for students of all classes (FY, SY, TY, and PG). Dr. Roshan D'Souza and Dr. Meeta Saxena were the resource persons.
- **8.** The online orientation program for the first-year degree college students (FYBA, FYBSc, FYBA SCJ, and FYBSc IT) was held successfully on 8th September 2021. It was streamed live on YouTube.
- **9.** The CAS committee scrutinized files for teachers due for promotion, and interviews were successful. The JD's office successfully promoted the staff members.
- **10.** IQAC has played a pivotal role in administering College Assessment questionnaires and parents' feedback via Google forms for the previous year.

- **11.** In the second half of the academic year 2021-2022, IQAC floated the Google forms to collect Covid vaccination data from the students, teachers, and the non-teaching staff and submitted the same whenever the Government, the University of Mumbai, and the Joint Director asked for it. The College met all deadlines and successfully shared the data with the concerned authorities. The College Union Committee and Mrs. Boskey Martis were very helpful in collecting the above data from the students and the non-teaching staff.
- **12.** Re-opening the college post-Covid was challenging. In order to improve the infrastructural quality, the college installed new MTNL internet connections in the Arts, Science, and BMM buildings, and upgraded the existing connections for better Wi-Fi connectivity. Dr. (Sr.) Ananda Amritmahal, Vice-Principals and Mr. Qamar ensured it happened successfully. Dr. Tendulkar stressed that the internet connections continue to give problems sometimes, and the installation of a new Jio connection in the administrative wing is in progress.
- **13.** The IQAC organized the online prize distribution ceremony for the 2019-2020 batch on 4th December 2021 which was streamed live on YouTube, and the IQAC planned for the online screening in the College for the faculty members. The committee also organized the online prize distribution ceremony for the 2020-2021 batch on 16th March 2022, which was streamed live on YouTube as well.
- **14.** The IQAC organized its Annual Conference on Wellness management: Nutrition & Therapy on 29th April 2022 for the teaching faculty. Ms. Sukhada Bhatte, Dietician and Nutritionist, Hexagon Nutrition Ltd, and Dr. Tejsvi Kamble, Occupational Therapist, were the resource persons. Ms. Tanaz Asha, Coordinator, IQAC program committee played an instrumental role in holding this conference successfully. RUSA supported this conference.
- **15.** IQAC released its first edition of Lucid A peer-reviewed multidisciplinary research journal for teachers and research scholars, which is a flagship publication. This research journal is an addition to the existing College research journal Scribe. The IQAC has planned to launch and publish one more research journal for students called Luminous.
- **16.** IQAC held the online elections for student body president and cultural secretary for 2022-23, with the IQAC coordinator Dr. Anagha Tendulkar acting as the presiding officer. Ms. Aditi Gupta was elected as the Student Body President and Ms. Mihika Hajela, the cultural secretary.

The meeting ended with Vote of thanks by the Coordinator.

- 1. The IQAC/college launched the newly designed, vibrant, and fully functional website.
- 2. IQAC successfully published the soft/e-copy of the College handbook for the year 2021-2022 on the new website.
- 3. IQAC played a pivotal role in the College's participation in the India Today survey, the Week Survey, and the NIRF rankings.
- 4. IQAC Organized RUSA Supported webinar "Launching add on courses key components" on 10th July 2021 to make all staff members aware of the design, structure, and elements of the add-on courses. The session was conducted by our in-house faculty member Dr. Roshan D'Souza (HOD Zoology). In the session Dr. D'Souza explained to teaching faculty how to launch, form, and float good add on courses.
- 5. Program committee conducted a series of online orientation sessions on Add-on credits and Swayam courses for students of all classes (FY, SY, TY, and PG). Dr. Roshan D'Souza and Dr. Meeta Saxena were the resource persons. The sessions were conducted on 1st July, 5th July, 23rd July, 22nd and 23rd October 2021.
- 6. The online orientation program for the first-year degree college students (FYBA, FYBSc, FYBA SCJ, and FYBSc IT) was held successfully on 8th September 2021. It was streamed live on YouTube. An orientation programme for FYJC students was held on 7th October 2021. It was streamed live on YouTube as well.
- 7. The CAS committee scrutinized files for teachers due for promotion, and interviews were successful. The JD's office successfully promoted the staff members.
- 8. There were two audits for the previous academic year done during the year i.e., Examination Audit and Academic Audit.
- 9. In the second half of the academic year 2021-2022, IQAC floated the Google forms to collect Covid vaccination data from the students, teachers, and the non-teaching staff and submitted the same whenever the Government, the University of Mumbai, and the Joint Director asked for it. The College met all deadlines and successfully shared the data with the concerned authorities.
- 10. In order to improve the infrastructural quality, the college installed new MTNL internet connections in the Arts, Science, and the Sophia Anderson Annexe buildings, and upgraded the existing connections for better Wi-Fi connectivity and installed routers and wiring to make all the rooms Wi-fi enabled.
