Report of NSS activities (2018-19)

The academic year 2018-2019 saw a revitalization of NSS unit of the college. As per university allotment we enrolled 200 volunteers in our NSS unit. An orientation session was conducted for them by the Area Coordinator, Prof. Kranti Ukey on 1st September, 2018. A synopsis of the main activities completed by a NSS unit is given below:

1) Swachh Bharat Activities: (Screening, Swachh Bharat area project, Talk.):

- Swachh Bharat Area Project (8th August, 2018 15th February, 2019): 1) Introduction Orientation session 2) Plastic ban debate and discussion 3) Haloli Visit (teaching and tree plantation) 4) Pledge taking and Eco-friendly (Independence Day) March 5) Campus Cleaning 6) Cloth Bag Collection and Distribution at Grant Road Station and market 7) Online Survey 8) Talk by Anjana Oza 9) Kitchen Compost and Waste Segregation to promote waste composting at a society level Waste segregation and kitchen composting which was later distributed to the neighbors of the volunteers.
- A Screening on 'Plastic Ban' and on 'Reduce, Reuse and Recycle' was held on 16th January.

(11) Surgical Strike Day: (26th September) Digital Card Making.

- 2) <u>Awareness Programs</u> (NSS week, MDACS Poster making, Red Ribbon club, Screening on Plastic ban, Road Safety, Knowing the Penguin: Byculla Zoo Project Communal Harmony, Walk.):
 - NSS week was celebrated with the following activities 1) Debate on Gandhism on 28th September. 2) Poster Making on Environmental Pollution on 27th September. 3) Documentary Screening on Water Pollution on 26 September.
 - Knowing the Penguin: Byculla Zoo project was a 20 Area hour project organized by Sophia College from 11th to 18th November, 2018 (1st Batch) and from 13th Jan (2nd Batch) wherein the volunteers visited and helped at the zoo, whilst learning more about penguins.
 - Road Safety Area Project (9th- 24th February, 2019) was organized to spread awareness on road safety and its importance, the following activities were conducted in which 45 students participated. 1) Orientation program 2) Poster Making and Display 3) One on One interaction 4) Story and Essay writing 5) Pledge wall 6) PPT / video compilation 7) Guest lecture 8) Quiz.
 - Red Ribbon Club area project was organized to spread awareness about HIV/AIDS from 12 January to 15th Feb, 2019, these were the following activities conducted for the same. 88 students participated. 1) Blood Donation Camp with TATA Memorial Hospital 2) Human Chain Formation and Pledge 3) T-shirt painting 4) Guest Lecture on HIV/AIDS 5) Documentary Screening.
 - MDACS poster making was held to spread awareness about HIV AIDS at Wadala on 26th November.
 - A Poetry Slam was held to celebrate Communal Harmony on 7th August.
 - A Screening on <u>'Plastic Ban' and on 'Reduce, Reuse and Recycle'</u> was held on 16th January.
 - WALK WITH ME...EASY MY PAIN' was a Walk arranged to spread awareness about the life of Cancer Patients on 13th October.
- 3) Empowerment and Programs for Women and Weaker Sections in society (Poetry writing, Diya sale, Notebook Making and Distribution, Talks, Self-Defense, Workshop and Orientations, Kerala Relief.):
 - Talk about 'Underprivileged children on personality training' was held on 28 November, 2018. Another talk on Sexual Harassment at Workplace on 16th October, 2018 by Majlis.
 - On International girl child's day, 10th October, 2018 a poetry writing competition was held.
 - A Notebook Making workshop was held on 13th December, 2018 and the books of the produced were distributed at Haloli village.

- Self-Defense area project was organized to learn self-defense from 15th 22nd December, 2018 and 56 students participated. It was conducted by Ms. Bhavana Chavan and Ms. Shreya Kamble of Combat of Taekwondo Academy to teach young girls to protect themselves, they were therefore given self-defense training for the same.
- A 'Diya sale' was organized on 11th October and the money collected from it will be used in the upcoming year for sponsoring stationery (books, pens, textbooks, etc.) to our adopted village- Haloli's school kids. 67 students participated in the sale.
- A Collection Drive of food, medicines and toiletries was held on 20th August for Kerala after the unfortunate floods, extending our support to the state.
- 4) Green Initiative (Tree Plantation, Cloth Bag collection and distribution, Rangoli and Video Making, Caption and Poetry Writing, Discussion, Save Water, Save Electricity.):
 - Tree Plantation drive was organized at Amarson Gardens on 7th July,2018, likewise 43 volunteers planted tree saplings in their own societies in the first week of July. Likewise Tree Plantation was also done at Haloli village on 28th July and 66 volunteers participated.
 - Camp Activities: 1) Vanrai Bandhara (1 dam) construction. 2) Tree Plantation. 3) Cloth Bag Distribution.
 - Cloth bag collection (8 August to 6th September) and distribution was held at the University level and under Swachh Bharat area project, they were distributed at Grant Road Station and market (6th September) as well as at Haloli village (28th July)
 - Rangoli and Video Making endorsing 'Pollution Free Diwali' during Diwali break (5th to 10th November, 2018) at their respective homes.
 - Diya Painting Workshop was held on 4th October to endorse Pollution free Diwali.
 - Caption and Poetry Writing was held on 12th February, 2019 on the theme <u>'Environment Conservation'</u>.
 - Discussion on the careful use of water was organized on 26th September, 2018 on College Campus.
 - Save Water Area Project organized the following activities to spread awareness from 21st December, 2018 to 15 February, 2019 and 56 students participated. 1) Poster Making 2) Questionnaire making and Report Writing 3) Social Media Posting – An online initiative to spread awareness about water conservation 4) Spreading Awareness-Video Making 5) Talk and discussion on water conservation 6) Online survey 7) Documentary screening on 'Life without Water' 8) Interviewing people about water conservation and spreading awareness.
 - Save Electricity Area Project from 24 December, 2018 to 4th January, 2019 to spread a speareness about usage of alternative energies and 44 students participated. The activities conducted are: 1) Questionnaire making for survey and interview 2) Statistical

 - A Thalassemia and Anemia detection check-up was held on 20th August Sophia College and 40 participants were present.
 - A street play on organ donation was conducted at Grant Road Station on 9th October 2018. Blood donation drive was conducted as a part of RRC on 1st February, 2019 and 116 students participated.
 - Blood donation drive was held on 20th August, 2018 in Sophia College.
 - A Rally for <u>'Freedom From Addiction'</u> was held on 1st October, 2018 from Azad Maidan to Gateway of India. (University event).
 - A Workshop on <u>'De-addiction and its Prevention'</u> was held at Siddharth College on 11th December, 2018. (University event).
 - A Lecture was held on 'Cardiac related Health Issues and Awareness' at the University hall on 17th December, 2018.
 - Health and hygiene area project was conducted from 29th January to 22nd February, 2019. The following activities were undertaken for the same:- 1) Talk on Menstrual cups 2) Survey on hygiene and cleanliness 3) Social Media and Campus Awareness 4) Documentary screening Diabulimia: The world's most dangerous eating disorder 5) Preparing healthy recipes 6) Preparation of diet chart 7) Talk on Polycystic Ovary Disease 8) Body Mass Index Test.
 - Yoga Sessions were held from 16th to 18th October in college for the 33 volunteers to inculcate the habit of practicing Yoga.


