






E) What degree program are you pursuing now? (2023-2024)


F) What subject area are you currently pursuing? (2023-2024)










4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as


5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.














12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.














19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

These are the suggestions and observations that I have concluded from my experience so far.

1.The teachers that are employed to teach us are rarely equipped with the adequate knowledge and experience in the area of the subject, thus sometimes making their teaching incomprehensible and irrelevant to the subject. I suggest to improve the teaching staff with more experienced and knowledgeable faculty especially in a specialised degree programme.

2.The use of technology incorporated in teaching is bare minimum and sometimes only incorporated when asked or suggested by student such as the use of PPTs etc. This hinders with the learning process of students in this day and age as the use of visual and interactive mediums play a significant part. I suggest in incorporating more use of technology in the teaching and learning processes.

3. Lastly, based on my personal learning experience in my course I strongly believe that in order to improve the quality and the overall learning experience the requirement of more in house teaching faculty and less freelance teaching faculty is necessary.
